The Todd Ouida Children's Foundation

(www.mybuddytodd.org) was established to create a meaningful legacy for Todd Ouida, whose life was tragically ended in the September 11th terrorist attack on the World Trade Center ten years ago. Born of Todd's own successful struggle with childhood anxiety, the foundation financially supports childhood mental health initiatives and seeks to raise awareness and reduce the stigma of childhood anxiety and depression.



This year we are partnering with **Children's Aid and Family Services** (www.cafsnj.org), with whom the foundation has collaborated for many years. In addition to the organizations and services we regularly support, funds raised at this year's event will help support a medical services and advocacy center for children in the agency's foster care.

The mission of Children's Aid and Family Services is to preserve, protect and, when needed, provide families. Founded in 1899, the agency primarily helps children who have no family able to care for them as well as families who are facing challenges and transitions in life.
